



PROJECT # 20 INSTRUCTION SHEET

CORRUGATED PAPER LANTERN WITH POSTS

Materials:

- 1 - Sheet of corrugated Wyndstone Paper #163253 (or a decorative Black Ink paper)
- 10 - 12" long skewers
- 10 - Decorative beads to cap top (or bottom) of skewers
- Gold spray paint or gold metallic wax
- Tacky glue

Equipment:

- Exacto knife
- Cutting mat
- 12" metal ruler approximately 11/4" wide
- Pencil and eraser

Instruction Steps:

1) Cut your paper to size of 14" W x 10 1/2" H. For corrugated paper, make sure that the ridges are running vertically, in the same direction of the height of the paper.

2) On the reverse side (smooth side) of the corrugated paper, start measuring. Start on one edge, and draw vertical lines the width of the ruler, continue to the end.

3) Still on the reverse side, starting on the second column, and a ruler's width down, start cutting slits, alternating columns.

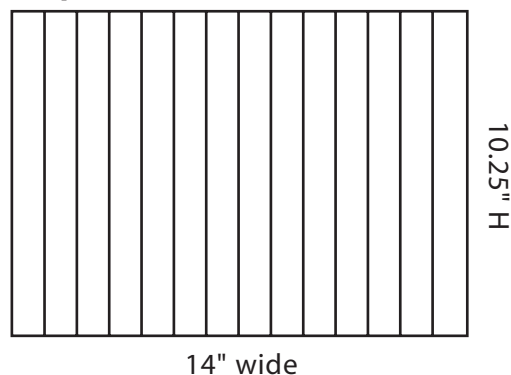
4) On the uncut rows, you will be cutting slits with the ruler 1/2 drop down (about 5/8" down), so that for every other column, the slits are cut at the same height, creating a brickwork pattern.

5) Spray paint the back side (smooth side), dry.

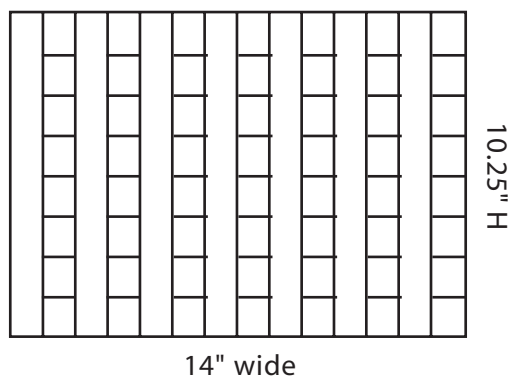
6) Start weaving the skewers top to bottom, sharp end pointed down, but do not insert the last skewer yet. When you come to the last row, trim to remove bulk. Make sure that the corrugation is on the outside and start rolling into a cylinder. Insert last skewer through double thickness to join.

7) Cut a bit off the skewers sharp tip and glue on the beads to form the feet. A tea light candle properly protected, makes it light up quite nicely.
