### PROJECT #22 INSTRUCTION SHEET

# TRIBAL RATTLE

#### **Materials:**

- Black Ink Thai Rock Art paper, #TD-2592
- · Small dried gourd or papier mache form
- Dowel or small branch
- Mod Podge and tacky glue
- Pebbles

## **Equipment:**

- Scissors
- Brushes

## **Instruction Steps:**

- 1) Cut off neck of gourd, leaving opening just large enough to insert the handle (dowel or small branch).
- 2) Apply paper to gourd with Mod Podge or watered down tacky glue. (Note: Mod Podge leaves a shiny finish, where as tacky glue leaves more of a satin finish).
- 3) Insert pebbles in gourd and attach handle with tacky glue. Dry.
- 4) Make a braid using 6 strips of paper cut 1/2" wide, to desired length (at least long enough to wrap a couple of times around the neck of the gourd and handle).
- 5) When handle is dry, wrap braid around neck of handle using tacky glue. Fringe the ends of the braid.
- 6) If needed, add a finishing top coat to the gourd with either Mod Podge or watered down tacky glue, depending on desired finish.
